MEETING SUMMARY:

This task group actively updates the voluntary standard for trampoline courts, ASTM F2970 – 20 *Standard Practice for Design, Manufacture, Installation, Operation, Maintenance, Inspection and Major Modification of Trampoline Courts*.

The meeting began with a discussion of a proposed fix to some of the measurements used to describe the strength requirements for the trampoline in section 7.10. In the conversion from imperial to metric units, some units of force (lbs) were improperly converted to units of stress (MPa). CPSC staff provided technical input to support the discussion.

The group briefly reviewed the title, scope, and significance of use sections of the standard, and decided not to make any substantial changes in these sections. During the review, CPSC staff suggested that the term “anthropomorphic” in section 6.1.2 should be changed to “anthropometric” while being used to refer to measurements of the human body relating age, weight, and size.

The group next discussed how to modify the standard to include requirements for performance trampoline beds. The group focused on the use of “zones” to describe separate areas of different types of trampolines. The discussion was to be continued during the next meeting.

The next Trampoline Courts task group meeting is scheduled to take place on February 17 via teleconference.
